**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4125**

1 Delete lines 12 through 19 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “(1) A cancellation of a policy is not effective unless the insurer mails
3 or delivers a notice of cancellation to the named insured:

4 “(a) At least 30 days before the effective date of the cancellation, if the
5 policy or coverage has been in effect for 60 days or more on the date on
6 which the insurer mails or delivers the notice of cancellation;

7 “(b) At least 10 days before the effective date of the cancellation, if the
8 cancellation is for nonpayment of premium; or

9 “(c) At least 10 days before the effective date of the cancellation, if the
10 policy or coverage has been in effect less than 60 days on the date on which
11 the insurer mails or delivers the notice of cancellation.

12 “(2) A notice under subsection (1)(a) or (b) of this section must include
13 a statement of the reason or reasons for the cancellation.

14 “(3) This section does not apply to nonrenewal.”
