

Requested by Senator DEMBROW

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 1564**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “declaring an emergency” and
2 insert “prescribing an effective date”.

3 On page 4, delete lines 3 through 12 and insert:

4 “(2) On and after the date that a mattress stewardship program is imple-
5 mented:

6 “(a) A producer, renovator or retailer may not sell or offer for sale any
7 mattress to any person in this state unless the producer, renovator or
8 retailer is registered with a stewardship organization with a plan approved
9 by the Department of Environmental Quality under section 6 of this 2020
10 Act; and

11 “(b) A retailer:

12 “(A) May purchase a mattress only from a producer or renovator that is
13 registered with a stewardship organization as of the date of purchase as ev-
14 idenced by information made available by a stewardship organization pursu-
15 ant to subsection (4) of this section;

16 “(B) Shall collect, at the point of retail sale, the mattress stewardship
17 assessment established pursuant to a plan approved by the department under
18 section 6 of this 2020 Act and remit the mattress stewardship assessment to
19 the stewardship organization that implements the mattress stewardship pro-
20 gram; and

21 “(C) Shall provide to consumers, at the point of retail sale, information

1 on available collection opportunities for discarded mattresses through the
2 mattress stewardship program.”.

3 On page 8, delete lines 33 through 43 and insert:

4 “(3)(a) Not less than once per month, a stewardship organization shall
5 provide written notice to the department of any changes made during the
6 previous month to a plan approved by the department under section 6 of this
7 2020 Act that are changes for which an amendment is not required under
8 subsection (1) of this section. Changes subject to notice under this subsection
9 include, but are not limited to:

10 “(A) A change in the location or the number of permanent collection sites
11 identified in the plan;

12 “(B) A change in the producers or renovators that are registered with the
13 stewardship organization; or

14 “(C) A change in the recyclers or renovators that manage the discarded
15 mattresses collected by the stewardship organization under the program.

16 “(b) If, upon receiving notice of a change under paragraph (a) of this
17 subsection, the department determines that the change would have a material
18 impact on the implementation or administration of the plan, the department
19 shall require the stewardship organization to submit the change to the de-
20 partment for approval.”.

21 On page 9, line 22, before the colon insert “, with respect to mattresses
22 collected in this state”.

23 On page 13, after line 3, insert:

25 **“REPORT TO LEGISLATURE**

27 **“SECTION 16. No later than December 31, 2022, the Department of**
28 **Environmental Quality shall submit a report to an appropriate com-**
29 **mittee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly describing**
30 **the results of the implementation of mattress stewardship programs**

1 **and the adequacy of enforcement mechanisms available to the de-**
2 **partment in regulating mattress stewardship programs. The depart-**
3 **ment may recommend statutory changes necessary to improve the**
4 **functioning and efficiency of mattress stewardship programs.”.**

5 In line 7, delete “16” and insert “17”.

6 In line 10, delete “17” and insert “18”.

7 In line 18, delete “18” and insert “19”.

8 In line 28, delete “19” and insert “20”.

9 Delete lines 32 through 36 and insert:
