**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4095**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “creating new”.

2 In line 3, delete “provisions;” and insert “amending section 9, chapter 52,
3 Oregon Laws 2016;”

4 Delete lines 5 through 30 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 1.** Section 9, chapter 52, Oregon Laws 2016, is amended to
6 read:

7 **“Sec. 9. (1)** The Land Conservation and Development Commission shall
8 report on the progress of the pilot program, in the manner provided in ORS
9 192.245, to the committees of the Legislative Assembly related to housing and
10 human services:

11 “[*1*] **(a)** At least once during each of [*three*] **eight** consecutive regular
12 sessions of the Legislative Assembly, beginning with the 2017 regular session
13 of the Legislative Assembly; and

14 “[*2*] **(b)** At least once following adjournment sine die of the regular
15 sessions of the Legislative Assembly described in [*subsection (1) of this sec-*
16 *tion*] **paragraph (a) of this subsection**, but no later than the convening of
17 the next regular session of the Legislative Assembly.

18 **“(2) The report given during the 2022 regular session of the Legis-**
19 **lative Assembly under subsection (1)(a) of this section must include**
20 **information regarding:**

21 **“(a) A summary and comparison of the experiences reported by the**

1 **cities participating in the pilot program;**

2 **“(b) An analysis of the potential effects of extending the pilot pro-**
3 **gram statewide;**

4 **“(c) Whether a statewide implementation of the pilot program**
5 **would significantly improve the availability of housing units;**

6 **“(d) The extent to which criteria for compliance with the pilot**
7 **program would be prohibitive for other cities if the program were ex-**
8 **tended statewide; and**

9 **“(e) Suggestions for additions to or subtractions from the criteria**
10 **for compliance with the program and elements of the program if the**
11 **pilot program were extended statewide and the anticipated effects of**
12 **implementing those suggestions.**

13 **“SECTION 2. (1) Sections 2, 3 and 5 to 8, chapter 52, Oregon Laws**
14 **2016, are repealed on January 2, 2028.**

15 **“(2) Section 4, chapter 52, Oregon Laws 2016, as amended by section**
16 **1, chapter 32, Oregon Laws 2019, is repealed on January 2, 2028.**

17 **“(3) Section 9, chapter 52, Oregon Laws 2016, as amended by section**
18 **1 of this 2020 Act, is repealed on January 2, 2028.”.**

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
