- On page 3 of the printed bill, line 11, delete "and".
- In line 13, delete the period and insert "; and".

- 4 "(c) The project complies with local floodplain regulations if the project
- is located within an area subject to floodplain management.".
- 6 In line 39, delete "(8)" and insert "(9)".
- 7 On page 4, after line 2, insert:
- 8 "(8)(a) Before authorizing a proposed voluntary project, the State De-
- 9 partment of Fish and Wildlife shall coordinate with the Department of
- 10 Transportation to consider any potential impacts of the project on transpor-
- tation infrastructure or planned transportation infrastructure, including but
- 12 not limited to potential impacts on roads, culverts and bridges.
- 13 "(b) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife, in coordination with the
- 14 Department of Transportation, may at any time require the person engaging
- in the authorized voluntary restoration project to modify environmental
- 16 restoration weirs if the environmental restoration weirs are found to ad-
- 17 versely impact transportation infrastructure or planned transportation
- 18 infrastructure.".

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- "(2) No later than September 15, 2031, the State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall submit a report, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to environment and natural resources on voluntary projects authorized under the program es-

- "(a) Assessments of the conditions of qualifying streams affected by authorized voluntary projects, which assess stream conditions prior to construction of environmental restoration weirs as well as after construction of environmental restoration weirs; and
 - "(b) Recommendations, which may include recommendations for legislation, regarding potential amendment of section 3 (2) of this 2020 Act to allow the department to authorize voluntary projects in which construction of environmental restoration weirs will commence on or after January 2, 2035."

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
