**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4035**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 14, after “The” insert “Department of
2 Revenue.”.

3 In line 15, after “Governor” insert “, in consultation with the Oregon
4 Cannabis Commission and licensees and other cannabis entities regulated by
5 the Oregon Liquor Control Commission.”.

6 In line 27, delete “and”.

7 In line 28, delete the period and insert “;

8 “(h) Assess the financial impact of the tracking system described in ORS
9 475B.177 on licensees as defined in ORS 475B.015 and the state and make
10 recommendations to improve the tracking system and reduce the cost of
11 tracking to cannabis businesses in Oregon; and

12 “(i) Ensure the timely sharing of tax compliance data with cities, counties
13 and the commission.”.

14 Delete line 29 and insert:

15 “(2) The authority, departments, office of the Governor and Oregon Liquor
16 Control Commission shall submit the”.

17 On page 2, after line 3, insert:

18 **“SECTION 3. Section 4 of this 2020 Act is added to and made a part
19 of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.545.**

20 **“SECTION 4. (1) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall
21 adopt rules to develop compliance education programs for licensees**

1 and cannabis entities regulated by the commission. In adopting rules
2 under this section, the commission shall consult with licensees and
3 other interested parties.

4 “(2) The rules adopted under this section must:

5 “(a) Clarify that participation in a compliance education program
6 is voluntary;

7 “(b) Establish mitigation periods for certain violations, as deter-
8 mined by the commission, of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.545 and rules
9 adopted under ORS 475B.010 to 475B.545; and

10 “(c) Include that the commission may offer recommendations on
11 the abatement of violations described in paragraph (b) of this sub-
12 section prior to taking any action specified in ORS 475B.256.

13 “(3) The commission may adopt other rules as necessary to carry
14 out this section.

15 **“SECTION 5. (1) Section 4 of this 2020 Act becomes operative on
16 January 1, 2021.**

17 **“(2) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission may take any action
18 before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that
19 is necessary to enable the commission to exercise, on or after the op-
20 erative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties,
21 functions and powers conferred on the commission by section 4 of this
22 2020 Act.”.**

23 In line 4, delete “3” and insert “6”.

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
