## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1530

On page 42 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 3 through 18 and insert:

- 3 "(b) If a trade-exposed natural gas user is in compliance with an approved
- 4 energy management system audit and implementation plan subject to sub-
- 5 section (3) of this section, the trade-exposed natural gas user shall receive
- 6 rate relief during the following years in the following amounts:
- 7 "(A) In 2025 and each year before 2030, the rate relief shall be equal to
- 8 the amount of revenue generated by the sale at auction of the allowances
- 9 allocated to the natural gas utility on behalf of that user under section 17
- 10 (1)(d) of this 2020 Act for that year; and
- 11 "(B) In 2030 and each year before 2051, the rate relief shall be equal to
- 12 97 percent of the amount of revenue generated by the sale at auction of the
- 13 allowances allocated to the natural gas utility on behalf of that user under
- section 17 (1)(d) of this 2020 Act for that year.".
- On page 83, after line 5, insert:
- 16 "SECTION 95h. No later than September 15, 2028, the Office of
- 17 Greenhouse Gas Regulation, in consultation with the Public Utility
- 18 Commission, shall submit a report, in the manner provided under ORS
- 19 192.245, to an appropriate interim committee of the Legislative As-
- 20 **sembly that:**

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"(1) Describes and evaluates the emissions reductions and energy

saving improvements made by trade-exposed natural gas users in Oregon since the operative date of sections 4 to 32 of this 2020 Act; and "(2) Evaluates whether the provisions related to trade-exposed natural gas users in sections 17 (1)(d) and 50 of this 2020 Act are resulting in the achievement of outcomes consistent with the purposes set forth in section 2 of this 2020 Act.".
