**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED
HOUSE BILL 4053**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after “433.375” insert
2 “and 433.377”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 26 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 433.375 is amended to read:

5 **“433.375. (1)(a) Except as provided in this paragraph, a county shall**
6 **condition the license for a dog for which inoculation is required under**
7 **ORS 433.365 upon the owner presenting a certificate of rabies inocu-**
8 **lation for the dog. A county may provide other means acceptable to**
9 **the Oregon Health Authority of verifying compliance with the rabies**
10 **inoculation requirement in ORS 433.365 for dog licensing purposes.**

11 **“(b) A county may allow a period of up to 60 days following issuance**
12 **of a dog license for the owner to present a certificate of rabies inocu-**
13 **lation for the dog or for the county to receive verification of rabies**
14 **inoculation by other acceptable means.**

15 **“(2) The owner of [*the animal shall present by mail or otherwise the in-***
16 ***oculation certificate, together with*] a dog for which inoculation is required**
17 **under ORS 433.365 shall submit** the fee fixed pursuant to ORS 433.380, if
18 any, to the clerk of the county in which the owner resides.

19 **“[(2) *The county shall upon receipt of the fee and presentation of the cer-***
20 ***tificate*] Upon the county receiving the fee, and receiving a certificate**
21 **of rabies inoculation for the dog or other rabies inoculation verifica-**

1 **tion allowed by the county, the county shall** issue to the owner a
2 serial-numbered tag, legibly identifying its expiration date as such date is
3 determined in accordance with rules of the Oregon Health Authority relating
4 to intervals of inoculation. The tag shall be designed for and shall be at-
5 tached to a collar or harness that must be worn by the dog for which the tag
6 and certificate are issued at all times when off or outside the premises of the
7 owner. Whenever an original tag is lost, mutilated or destroyed, upon appli-
8 cation and payment of the fee prescribed under ORS 433.380, if any, a re-
9 placement tag, to be dated, designed and worn as the original, shall be
10 issued.

11 “[*(3) No official of any county shall issue a license for a dog until the of-*
12 *ficial has been shown a proper certification, or its equivalent, of a rabies in-*
13 *oculation.*.]

14 “[*(4)*] **(3)** If the county files [*the certificate upon which a tag is issued, it*
15 *shall be*] **a certificate of rabies inoculation or other rabies inoculation**
16 **verification for a dog issued a tag under this section, the county shall**
17 **ensure that the certificate or other inoculation verification is** cross-
18 referenced to the tag number. If the certificate **or other verification** is not
19 filed, the county shall keep an appropriate record of the expiration date and
20 number, if any, of the certificate **or other verification** cross-referenced to
21 the tag number. Notwithstanding ORS 205.320 (1)(a), a fee is not required for
22 filing the certificate **or other verification**.

23 “[*(5)*] **(4)** Unexpired tags shall be honored in all counties when the [*ani-*
24 *mal*] **dog** is in transit or where the owner has established a new residence.

25 “[*(6)*] **(5)** The provisions of this section apply to a city, rather than a
26 county, in a city that has a dog licensing program.

27 **“SECTION 2.** ORS 433.377 is amended to read:

28 “433.377. [*Notwithstanding ORS 433.375 or any other provision of law,*]
29 **Except as provided in this section,** a county or city may consider issuance
30 of a license for a dog as verification of there being [*a certificate*] **proof** of

1 inoculation on file **or otherwise recorded** and need not issue a tag pursuant
2 to ORS 433.375 [(2)]. **A county or city may not consider a license to be**
3 **verification of rabies inoculation during the 60 days following issuance**
4 **of the license.”.**

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
