- "SECTION 1. (1)(a) A request for proof of payment, to determine whether a person has paid user charges, fees or tolls imposed by a
- mass transit district under ORS 267.320, may be made only by an
- 5 enforcement officer as defined in ORS 153.005, or another authorized
- 6 district employee, who is not a peace officer.
- 7 "(b) A peace officer may not check for an arrest warrant for a
- 8 person who has committed, or who is suspected of committing, only
- 9 the offense of:

- "(A) Failing to pay a user charge, fee or toll imposed by a mass transit district under ORS 267.320; or
 - "(B) Failing to provide proof of payment of a user charge, fee or toll imposed by a mass transit district under ORS 267.320.
 - "(2) Nothing in this section prohibits a peace officer from:
- "(a) Assisting in identifying a person, or conducting any authorized activities reasonably related to the issuance of a citation, once an enforcement officer or another authorized district employee has reasonable suspicion that the person has violated an ordinance of a mass transit district related to payment of user charges, fees or tolls;
- 20 "(b) Being present on the property of, or in a motor or light rail 21 vehicle of, a mass transit district;

- "(c) Enforcing laws that are not related to payment of user charges,
- 2 fees or tolls imposed by a mass transit district under ORS 267.320; or
- "(d) Intervening in any situation in which the safety of any person is at risk.
- "(3) A mass transit district is immune from liability for any claim for injury to or death of any person, or injury to property, resulting from a peace officer's nonparticipation in a fare enforcement mission as required by this section.
 - "(4) As used in this section:

- "(a) 'Fare enforcement mission' means activities intended to determine whether a person has paid user charges, fees or tolls imposed by a mass transit district under ORS 267.320.
- 13 "(b) 'Peace officer' has the meaning given that term in ORS 14 133.005.".
