PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO B-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4001

On page 5 of the printed B-engrossed bill, delete lines 20 through 35 and insert:

"SECTION 11. Notwithstanding ORS 458.650 (2) and (3), the Housing and Community Services Department may expend funds from the Emergency Housing Account to award grants and provide technical assistance under section 9 of this 2020 Act.

"SECTION 12. Sections 9, 10 and 11 of this 2020 Act are repealed on January 2, 2022.

"SECTION 13. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General
Fund, for deposit into the Emergency Housing Account established
under ORS 458.620, the following amounts:

- "(1) \$26,500,000 for grants under section 9 of this 2020 Act; and
- 15 "(2) \$2,000,000 for technical assistance under ORS 458.650 (4)(b) and 16 section 9 of this 2020 Act.

"SECTION 14. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount established by section 2, chapter 642, Oregon Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses for operations from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds from the United
