

Requested by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4024**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, delete “prescribing an  
2 effective date” and insert “declaring an emergency”.

3 On page 2, line 3, after “systems” insert “or in other airplane parts sub-  
4 ject to certification requirements of the Federal Aviation Administration”.

5 Delete lines 4 through 12 and insert:

6 **“SECTION 3.** (1) A person may not offer any product or equipment for  
7 sale, lease or rent, or install or otherwise cause any equipment or product  
8 to enter into commerce, in Oregon if that product or equipment consists of,  
9 uses or will use a substitute listed in appendices U and V, subpart G of 40  
10 C.F.R. part 82, as in effect on January 3, 2017, for the applications or end  
11 uses restricted by appendix U or V, subpart G of 40 C.F.R. part 82, as in ef-  
12 fect on January 3, 2017, and that product or equipment was manufactured  
13 after the deadline established by subsection (2) of this section. Except where  
14 an existing product or equipment is retrofit, nothing in this section requires  
15 a person that acquired a restricted product or equipment prior to the dead-  
16 line established by subsection (2) of this section to cease use of that product  
17 or equipment.”.

18 On page 3, delete lines 35 through 41 and insert:

19 **“SECTION 4. The Department of Consumer and Business Services**  
20 **shall adopt rules as necessary to align the state building code with**  
21 **section 3 of this 2020 Act and rules adopted by the Environmental**

1 **Quality Commission pursuant to section 3 of this 2020 Act.”.**

2 On page 4, delete lines 6 and 7 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**  
4 **General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Environ-**  
5 **mental Quality by section 1 (1), chapter 663, Oregon Laws 2019, for the**  
6 **biennium ending June 30, 2021, for air quality, is increased by \$176,600**  
7 **for the implementation of sections 2 and 3 of this 2020 Act.**

8 **“SECTION 8. This 2020 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
9 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
10 **declared to exist, and this 2020 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
