**RE: Support of Legislative Concept 39 (2020 1st Special Session)  
Rural Telecommunications Investment Act**

Dear Co-Chairs Kotek and Courtney, Co-Vice Chairs Girod and Drazan and  
Members of the Joint Interim Committee on the First Special Session of 2020:

In its last report to the Legislative Assembly in 2018, OBAC stated that it believes that Oregon's broadband public policy needs to be focused on the future, be more aggressive, be more financially supportive, be more specific, and have a renewed sense of urgency. The COVID-19 Pandemic Crisis has created that sense of urgency.

In its last report, OBAC recommended that the state provide funding for new grant, loan and loan guarantee programs for broadband in unserved and underserved areas of the state, and for matching funds to leverage federal funding programs in support of new broadband infrastructure, community broadband planning, digital inclusion, cyber-security, education, public safety, agriculture, and network interconnection. The COVID-19 Pandemic Crisis has illustrated the importance of this critical work.

In its last report, OBAC recommended that the state should repurpose and redesign the Oregon Universal Service Fund to be sustainable and to improve and subsidize broadband infrastructure in unserved and underserved areas of the state.
