

## **STATEMENT OF SUPPORT:** HB 4208-1 or -2 (LIMITING THE USE OF TEAR GAS AND ACOUSTIC DEVICES)

Co-Chairs and Members of the Joint Committee:

For the record, my name is Michael Selvaggio, representing the Oregon Coalition of Police and Sheriffs (ORCOPS). ORCOPS supports HB 4208, as amended by either the 4208-1 or 4208-2 amendments, which seek to limit the use of tear gas and acoustic devices by law enforcement officers.

The purpose of these tools is to allow law enforcement officers to <u>maintain distance and de-escalate a situation</u>, but they should not be casually deployed when more passive de-escalation methods may be more appropriate.

Both the 4208-1 and 4208-2 amendments to the bill allow for the rare instances where such tools represent the safest options available, while still ensuring that their use does not become a "go-to" resolution in otherwise peaceful demonstrations.

ORCOPS urges your support of the measure as amended by either 4208-1 or 4208-2.
