

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5711

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON THE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION OF 2020

June 26

1 Delete lines 4 through 15 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
3 made to the Emergency Board by section 1, chapter 644, Oregon Laws 2019, for the biennium
4 ending June 30, 2021, is decreased by \$1,448,157.

5 “**SECTION 2.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
6 priated to the Office of the Governor, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the
7 General Fund, the amount of \$175,000 for expenses related to forest mediation sessions.

8 “**SECTION 3.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
9 priated to the State Forestry Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the
10 General Fund, the amount of \$844,545 for expenses related to notifications for pesticide ap-
11 plication by helicopter to forestland.

12 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$70,362
13 is established for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of
14 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and includ-
15 ing federal funds from the United States Forest Service for fire protection and for research
16 projects, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected
17 or received by the State Forestry Department, for expenses related to notifications for pes-
18 ticide application by helicopter to forestland.

19 “**SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
20 made to the State Department of Agriculture by section 1 (2), chapter 452, Oregon Laws 2019,
21 for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, for food safety, is increased by \$237,648 for the es-
22 tablishment of a state inspection program for the processing and sale of meat products.

23 “**SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
24 made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (1), chapter 668, Oregon Laws 2019,
25 for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, for central services and state assessments and
26 enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$137,042 for the purpose of licensing and monitoring
27 out-of-state child-caring agencies.

28 “**SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
29 made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (3), chapter 668, Oregon Laws 2019,
30 for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, for child welfare, is increased by \$53,922 for costs as-
31 sociated with managing out-of-state placements and covering service payments.

32 “**SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
33 expenditures established by section 2 (5), chapter 668, Oregon Laws 2019, for the biennium
34 ending June 30, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
35 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medicare receipts and including federal

1 funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental Security Income recoveries
2 and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not
3 described in section 2, chapter 668, Oregon Laws 2019, collected or received by the Depart-
4 ment of Human Services, for shared services, is increased by \$119,328 for the purpose of li-
5 censing and monitoring out-of-state child-caring agencies.

6 **“SECTION 9.** This 2020 special session Act being necessary for the immediate preserva-
7 tion of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2020
8 special session Act takes effect on its passage.”.
