PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4202

- On page 9 of the printed bill, delete lines 25 and 26 and insert:
- "SECTION 5. Sections 6 and 6a of this 2020 special session Act are added to and made a part of ORS 317A.100 to 317A.158.".
- 4 After line 45, insert:

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- 5 "SECTION 6a. (1) As used in this section, 'goods' includes food, 6 beverages and supplies.
- "(2) A credit against the taxes otherwise due under ORS 317A.100 to 317A.158 is allowed for the purchase price of perishable goods purchased by a taxpayer for use in the taxpayer's business, if:
 - "(a) The goods were purchased on a date on which the business in which the goods were intended for use was subject to a required closure pursuant to the declaration of a state of emergency issued by the Governor on March 8, 2020;
 - "(b) The taxpayer was unable to use the goods in the taxpayer's business due to the required closure and the goods were subsequently spoiled, destroyed or otherwise rendered unusable during the required closure; and
- 18 "(c) The taxpayer substantiates the purchase price and the date of 19 purchase of the goods.
- 20 "(3) The credit allowed under this section shall be reduced by the 21 amount of any other compensation that the taxpayer receives for the

- loss of the goods for which the credit is claimed.
- "SECTION 6b. Section 6a of this 2020 special session Act applies to
- 3 tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2020, and before January

4 **1, 2021.**".

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
