## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4212

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the line and delete lines 2 through 4 and insert "and declaring an emergency.".
- Delete lines 6 through 9 and delete pages 2 through 23 and insert:
- 5 "SECTION 1. Sections 2 and 3 of this 2020 special session Act are added to and made a part of ORS chapter 657.
- "SECTION 2. Notwithstanding ORS 657.155 and 657.165, an individual is eligible to receive benefits for the first week of a valid claim under this chapter.
- "SECTION 3. The Director of the Employment Department shall seek to enter into an agreement with the United States Secretary of Labor for purposes of section 2105 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (P.L. 116-136).
- "SECTION 4. Section 2 of this 2020 special session Act is repealed on the later of January 2, 2021, or the day after the date on which federal law reinstates a penalty on states for not requiring as a condition of eligibility that an individual wait a period of one week before receipt of benefits under ORS chapter 657.
- "SECTION 5. Section 3 of this 2020 special session Act is repealed on the later of January 2, 2021, or the day after the date of expiration of section 2105 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security

1 Act (P.L. 116-136) or any extension of the expiration date.

"SECTION 6. This 2020 special session Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2020 special session Act takes effect on its passage."
