PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4201

- On page 1 of the printed bill, after line 3, insert:
- 2 "Whereas Black Lives Matter; and
- "Whereas the lives of Kendra James and Jason Washington mattered; and
- 4 "Whereas there is an inherent conflict of interest in asking local district
- 5 attorneys to investigate the officers upon whom they rely to obtain con-
- 6 victions in criminal cases; and
- 7 "Whereas internal investigations and local investigations have resulted
- 8 in a lack of justice for communities of color, which breeds distrust of law
- 9 enforcement and causes both direct and vicarious trauma upon those com-
- 10 munities; and
- "Whereas two years ago, the district attorney's office in Washington
- 12 County failed to hold an officer responsible for assaulting a man of Mexican
- 13 heritage who was posing for a booking photo, officers from the Washington
- 14 County Sheriff's Office, Multnomah County Sheriff's Office and the Oregon
- 15 State Police did not find that a crime had been committed, and this case was
- 16 not known until recent civil litigation; and
- "Whereas no matter how late it may come, Black, Indigenous and People
- of Color communities deserve justice for the past, and also deserve justice
- 19 for the present; and
- 20 "Whereas countless protesters, members of the media, medics and legal
- observers across Oregon who have been exercising their First Amendment

- rights have been victimized by a failure of local civilian oversight to rein in
- abuses of the use of force by law enforcement; now, therefore,".
