- Whereas the right to protest and the right to free speech are protected
- 8 by the United States Constitution; and
- 9 "Whereas we are in the midst of a global pandemic; and
- "Whereas tear gas is a chemical weapon that can cause severe eye and
  - respiratory pain, skin irritation, bleeding, nausea and blindness; and
- "Whereas individuals with preexisting health conditions such as asthma,
- 13 chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and hypertension can suffer severe
- 14 complications, including permanent disability or death if exposed to tear gas;

- "Whereas medical experts warn that tear gas could increase the risk of
- 17 disease transmission by inducing coughing and airway inflammation among
- 18 protestors; and
- "Whereas after World War I, the Geneva Protocol of 1925 banned the use
- 20 of tear gas in warfare; and
- "Whereas the use of tear gas could disproportionately harm individuals

- 1 exercising their First Amendment rights who have limited mobility or
- 2 underlying health conditions; and
- 3 "Whereas the use of tear gas endangers the health and safety of the
- 4 public irrespective of whether a global pandemic is occurring; now,
