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Measure Description:

Provides that during a statutorily declared emergency, the Governor may authorize the Director of the Department of Revenue to disclose certain information set forth in a tax report or return to the Director of the Employment Department, if the Director of the Department of Revenue determines that the administration of any federal or state law or program, including, but not limited to, administration of unemployment insurance laws and programs by the Employment Department, requires the disclosure of the information to enable the Employment Department to verify the identity or income level of any person for purposes related to the emergency or any consequences of the emergency.

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
