PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1701

1 On page 3 of the printed bill, delete lines 2 through 4 and insert:

<u>SECTION 3.</u> Sections 4 and 5 of this 2020 second special session
Act are added to and made a part of ORS chapter 657.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding ORS 657.155 and 657.165, an individual
is eligible to receive benefits for the first week of a valid claim under
this chapter.

"<u>SECTION 5.</u> The Director of the Employment Department shall
seek to enter into an agreement with the United States Secretary of
Labor for purposes of section 2105 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and
Economic Security Act (P.L. 116-136).

"SECTION 6. Section 4 of this 2020 second special session Act is repealed on the later of January 2, 2021, or the day after the date on which federal law reinstates a penalty on states for not requiring as a condition of eligibility that an individual wait a period of one week before receipt of benefits under ORS chapter 657.

16 "<u>SECTION 7.</u> Section 5 of this 2020 second special session Act is 17 repealed on the later of January 2, 2021, or the day after the date of 18 expiration of section 2105 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic 19 Security Act (P.L. 116-136) or any extension of the expiration date.

20 "SECTION 8. This 2020 second special session Act being necessary 21 for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety,

- 1 an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2020 second special session
- 2 Act takes effect on its passage.".
