I was no cause evicted in 11/2020. This was due to the sale of the property. We were only given a 3 week notice to move, and this was a super challenge. My roommate has been in that residence for 9 years, and I lived with her for 5 years. We were deeply entrenched into our home. Not to mention, we didn't have the money to move either.

My roommate's son rents a small house with his girlfriend. After cleaning out his double car garage, I filled that space with our belongings. She moved into a small room in that same house.

There is very limited space in that house. This is where my luck comes through. My best friend can't stand the Oregon cold, so he goes south for a few months, as retired people do this migration. Rightfully so, my buddy worked hard for years and has earned his retirement. I'm house sitting for him in his studio apartment. I'm very lucky for this temporary shelter. I need to find place of my own by March when my friend returns.

I was fired from a union job in 2016, and my union is still punishing me. I'm a stagehand, so I work large events. Or should I say I used to work large events, I haven't worked since March 2020. (If I new that 1 person would die because I worked a show, I would cancel that show. Covid? I'd rather not work and suffer rather than put 1 person in jeopardy)

The financial impact on me has been huge as unemployment is equal to about 4 hours of work a week. I live in deficit constantly, and I'm suppose to be saving up to get my own place. I also have charity issues, as I refuse charity often much as I can. I like to give to charities, not accept from. Collecting unemployment has been embarrassing and degrading. Food EBT card makes me feel like I'm draining the system. Although, without that food card I would starved.. literally.

So... you can think what ever you want or do what ever you please. The reality is...

People can be fired from their jobs and their union then takes the side of the employer, then blacklisting you with other employers. This happened, who cared accept me.

I've been tossed out of my home. Then new property owners the didn't want to refund the deposit because they didn't negotiate that into the purchase of the house. The house wasn't clean enough they said, has a direct connection to only having 3 weeks to move. My life has been flipped upside down over this eviction. This happened, who cares accept me.

So extend your pretend laws and think of yourselves as important people if you wish. Give yourselves pay raises and congratulate each other as you believe you've done a good job.

Laws don't matter if no one follows them and there's no consequence for breaking them. So instead of passing new laws or extending an eviction moratorium, why not fix the disconnect between the laws and the people??? Otherwise, you can pass any laws, do or say anything you want, none of it matters.

PS- Unemployment claim runs out after Christmas too. How many jokes can I tell in one email???
