As a property manager and property owner, we have heard first hand "I'm not going to pay rent until I have to". Consider this, since April 1, 2020 until today, we have approximately \$450,000 in unpaid rents. Sound horrifying, yes? Would it surprise you to learn that over 70% of this unpaid balance is held by less than 9% of the nearly 1,000 units we manage. Of the 9% who hold nearly 2/3 of the unpaid balance, over 90% have not paid a single dollar since April 1. This is in spite of unemployment, stimulus payments and extra unemployment amounts as a result of the pandemic

The Eviction Moratorium that you have enacted is literally killing the average housing provider while not helping those that TRULY need the help
