In too many cases, tenants are not paying rent because it has been made possible for them not to have to pay rent.

My opposition statement to bill LC-18 is simple.

If landlords/housing providers hurt by rent nonpaying tenants are to forgive 20% of rent owed by the tenants, then Landlords should be forgiven 20% of *taxes* – property, income, etc.! – and *expenses* incurred despite loss of rental income.
