Regarding LC 18; extending the eviction moratorium

As a non-profit affordable housing landlord, I can see how much our residents are struggling to pay rent and provide for themselves and their families. We are grateful for the assistance that we have received from the state to help these families. My resident services staff, working closely with our asset manager and property management, have spent many hours working hard to connect residents to this assistance. We know that providing opportunities to stay housed is one of the most important things that we can do right now

Please extend the eviction moratorium. The pandemic is not ending soon enough and residents are struggling. The thought that Oregon could see thousands of people become homeless when they are no longer able to maintain their housing is chilling. Some people impacted by COVID have not had a history of struggling financially and it is certainly tragic that their housing is no longer secure. Our residents, who started the pandemic already low income are definitely struggling mightily. Of course you know it is much harder and more costly to house people who have lost their housing as opposed to intervening so that people do not become homeless. It is also much more human to keep people housed and avoid the trauma and devastation that homelessness causes.

Finally, this pandemic has disproportionately affected communities of color, both in terms of devastating health impacts as well as economic hardship.

This is the right time to create some real safety for Oregonians so that they can stay housed until it is possible to restart their lives.
