Hello:

My name is Sylvia Machado, I live in South Salem, OR in a Manufactured Home Park. I am 73 years old and on Social Security.

When my husband passed away some years ago, I used the money from the life insurance to move to Salem and purchase 4 manufactured homes.

I live in one of the homes and I lease out three of these homes. This rental income is **greatly** needed to supplement my Social Security.

Now, with the current regulations, some of my tenants are not paying their rent. When no rental income is coming in, I still have to pay for the space rent, the taxes and the insurance on these homes.

This is catastrophically impacting my financial condition and my ability to survive. I cannot wait until mid-2021; and I am sure I'm not the only person in this situation.

I am urging the legislature to direct the state's emergency board to **distribute emergency rental** assistance funds as quickly as possible!
