Please extend the eviction moratorium through June, 2021. Not only will this keep families safe from COVID; it will give families more time to become financially and emotionally stable.

I have a neighbor who works to the best of her ability in- between surgeries (so far 2 out of 3 that she needs). The emotional drain on her is huge as she worries when she is late on the rent. The moratorium extension would lessen this stress. She is a person with a strong work ethic. Please continue working on behalf of Oregonians who will need help with the rent payments; help in paying back rent; help with moving costs to find work or to relocate for other related to COVID-19 reasons.
