CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$100,000,000 for the purposes for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$400,000,000, to be allocated for the state’s response to the COVID-19 pandemic public health emergency.

SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$100,000,000, to be allocated for the state’s wildfire recovery, prevention and preparedness activities.

SECTION 4. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$150,000,000, to provide distributions under section 2, chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2020 (third special session) (Enrolled House Bill 4401).

(2) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$50,000,000, to provide distributions under section 3, chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2020 (third special session) (Enrolled House Bill 4401).

SECTION 5. This 2020 third special session Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2020 third special session Act takes effect on its passage.
