Co-Chairs Taylor, and Salinas, Vice-Chairs, Knopp, and Boshart-Davis, and members of the redistricting committees:

For the record, my name is Lisa Buscho pronouns are [she/her] and I live in Eugene, Oregon. Recently widowed, I moved from Curry to Lane County about five years ago. I moved in part to be closer to one daughter living in Portland, as well as to have greater access to healthcare, education, and air transport. My other daughter and grandson also now reside in this district near me. As a nurse and risk manager in a national company, I was often away from home for my work. In the two most recent years, I have spent more time at home and in this community than ever before, travel being limited by the COVID-19 pandemic and my retiring this year.

I'd like to thank the committee for your work on the maps. While I live on the cusp of rural Lane County, my SW community is very much within Eugene city limits. Changes in public bus routes recently excluded my neighborhood, so commonly used driving and biking routes are very important to me as considerations in these maps. These routes include Hawkins Lane, Bailey Hill Road, 18<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, as well as the Delta and Randy Pape Beltline Highways. I often care for my grandson and volunteer at his school, Cesar Chavez Elementary off Chambers Street. We visit local parks such as Acorn, Spencer Butte, and Amazon. I frequent central Eugene as my gym, garden club, shopping, and medical care is located there.

Congress Plan A, House Plan C, and Senate Plan A make the most sense to me. They do not split parts of Eugene up as much and are without so many of the strange jigs in the main transportation routes as are listed on other maps. In addition, they incorporate and are mindful of the natural barriers and have some consideration to rural vs urban areas. Although it incorporates much of the more rural areas, House Plan C is a decent attempt to keep my community together.

Again, thanks so much for your service and your work on this important issue. Some of these maps are a good start but please keep in mind *what* I have shared about my community when finalizing them. I'm happy to answer any questions.
