My name is Zach Lindahl and I am the Director of Public Policy and Government Relations for the Washington County Chamber of Commerce. The Washington County Chamber of Commerce is a nonpartisan organization that represents more than 750 businesses who provide more than 50,000 jobs in Washington County, Oregon.

Over the last decade, Oregon's population has grown by 10.6 percent, making us the 9<sup>th</sup> fastest growing state in the nation. Washington County has grown even quicker, at a rate of 13.5 percent. This is very exciting for Washington County and the State of Oregon, as our home is becoming a more desirable place to live and conduct business.

With this growth comes the addition of a new Congressional seat in the US House of Representatives, as well as the redrawing of the State Senate and State House districts.
