

Please consider the following in regards to the upcoming redistricting meetings:

MAPS SHOULD NOT BE DRAWN TO FAVOR ONE POLITICAL PARTY OVER ANOTHER Oregonians expect lawmakers to draw political maps that are fair, that keep communities of common interest together, provide historically marginalized communities with the representation they deserve, and follow the requirements set forth in Oregon law.

HOW MAPS SHOULD BE DRAWN:

- Making sure that no district is drawn for the purposes of favoring any political party or Incumbent or diluting the voting strength of any language or ethnic minority group.
- Keeping counties and cities whole.
- Preserving communities of common interests.
- Ensuring that populations for each district be closely matched.
- Avoid crossing geographic or political boundaries and maintain transportation links.
