Redistricting plan B gives rural/small town people a better chance to participate and get representation that complements our lifestyles. We are all Oregonians but we simply arrange our priorities differently than our metropolitan counter parts do. If we intend to be united as Oregon citizens, then we must include the small voices as well.

Including Portland metro and surrounding suburban areas in my district effectively cancels my already tiny voice. I'm here and have been a lifelong Oregonian who has supported myself/raised a family for 5 decades. Shouldn't I and others like me be represented by someone who has our interests up front? That's what representative government is all about isn't it?
