Lane County Commissioner Jay Bozievich has stated that Monroe, Harrisburg, and Junction City should all be in the same district so their rural votes will not be overwhelmed by Eugene and Corvallis. HE IS WRONG! All three of these small towns are bedroom communities for people who work in Eugene and Corvallis, and even Salem.

These residents probably constitute at least 50% of the populations of each town, and are, in no way, "rural". It is unfair of Bozievich to ignore these residents; it only proves that he is not really familiar with the reality of these towns.

Please consider this in approving redistricting plans.
