In my opinion by looking at the proposed maps that are available for redistricting congressionally it would seem that the house Republican proposal looks most like the current map of our district. It seems to me that this would be the logical conclusion that we would just expand for population growth in our area and not redraw the district to make attempts for Democrats to have more influence by allowing metropolitan areas and values to influence non-metropolitan constituents.

Currently our Congressional government representatives is lopsided in that 83% percent of our representatives are of one particular party even though 45% of our population votes and registers for the opposing party and it's platform.
