

As a resident of Senate District 28, I support OPTION B map for Congressional Districts, OPTION B map for state Senate District and OPTION B for state House Districts.

I am sick and tired of 40% of the Population over-ruling 75% of the Electorate.

I am tired of the Valley and most especially Multnomah County, dictating to the rest of us, with whom they have no shared values or lifestyles.

I prefer OPTION B as proposed in the maps because they are the closest in adhering to the redistricting guidelines. The boundary lines of these map options are contiguous and appear to be in keeping with the customs and culture of the counties involved.

Option A does not meet these criteria and re-enforces the dictatorial conditions I would like to see removed or, in the least instance, balanced.

OPTION B maps meets the standards of Oregon law on population, and the transportation links.

Option A appears to ignore needing to meet that basic standard.

OPTION B for all three of these maps is in keeping with the geographic and political boundaries of the counties. OPTION B also does not unnecessarily divide the People of the same interest or custom and culture of the areas.

Option A fails to meet this basic rule of a civilized society.

I urge the committee to pass OPTION B map for the Congressional District redistricting choice.

I would also urge the committee to pass OPTION B maps for both the state Senate and House Districts.

For the Committee to do anything other will result in a violation of the redistricting guidelines and will most probably lead to lawsuits.

Please pass OPTION B on all three redistricting map proposals.
