

From what I see so far with Oregon State redistricting:

Map "C" appears the most balanced and has the input from both parties. As someone in Springfield, my community extends into Eugene and out into the rural areas....Springfield is not an island.

I experienced Republican gerrymandering here in Lane County in 2011 when they cut up Eugene, cramming most of the Dems into one district to limit the power of groups of Democrats to get representation. The districts are still cut up and squiggly. I was at the open meeting when 99 people testified NOT to change anything and 5 people said they wanted a new map. Two weeks later they county commissioners announced they were redistricting Lane County..... That's not listening to the people, that's gerrymandering.
