I am a mother of three children in district 12 and I work in diagnostic imaging.

I ask to be represented because redistricting matters. It's not fair that so many marginalized populations have been unrepresented. This is the opportunity to change that so that all Oregonians are represented fairly.

Maps that under populate the metro districts and push urban area voters into rural districts while overpopulating these same rural districts limits representation for rural voters and is a clear sign of gerrymandering. Our rural communities have very different needs and concerns than the urban centers and deserve representation and political boundaries that do not include urban areas. Unfortunately some of the proposed maps bring an inordinate amount of the Portland Metro area in to our rural communities.

Partisan gerrymandering with redistricting is a legitimate possibility in Oregon, and I am concerned about it because I live in a rural area. I wish to live in a state where I can trust the system and our democracy, to elect officials who truly represent the people.
