It is also important that these maps reflect the population and needs of my community. There is a growing population of LatinX residents in my area. They should be considered a community of interest that has an active stake in what happens in Oregon City and in this potential district.

The redistricting committee has a great opportunity in front of them. We have the opportunity to ensure that our congress, house, and senate maps are redrawn in a way that best serves our state and the unique communities that make up our population.
