First I'd like to thank you for your work in this important task of redrawing our district maps. Presently I feel underrepresented in both Houses due in part to, what I believe is, a mismatch of interests, political ideologies, and natural boundaries. The creation of new district maps is a chance to rectify some existing problems. Therefore, I support the Congressional Plan A as well as Legislative Plan C and hope you do as well for the following reasons:

Congressional Plan A keeps all of Lincoln and Benton counties together in the same district pairing Corvallis and Eugene with the Central Coast which makes sense because of the connection we have together in terms of our shared HWY 20, satellite campus connections between Oregon State and OCCC as well the need for us to have access to their major hospitals. Creating a new Senate District 6 which combines progressives with progressive and conservative with conservative seems wise so that we may move forward with our separate agendas concerning the environment and economic interests (fishing, logging, and tourism) without butting our heads together and creating loggerheads rather than progress.
