Terrific, David, thank you.

We had a really good meeting with a Massachusetts Senator yesterday. We have three bills advancing:

- [S. 1988](#) to give folks the right to choose a non-radiation-emitting utility meter without penalty for refusing a "smart" water, gas or electric meter
- [S. 129](#) to form a commission to investigate EMFs
- [H. 383](#) to form a 5G task force; initially this was introduced to address economic fairness, but after receiving testimony on the health and environmental impact of wireless, they began to investigate further

One of the facts that really hit home with the Senator yesterday was given by a citizen with a heart condition. Her doctors have advised it would pose a risk to have "smart" meters on her home. She provided her town with the medical letters and asked to retain her analog water meter. Rather than deferring to the medical experts, the town shut off her water.

Now, in this pandemic, she cannot even adhere to public safety recommendations to frequently wash hands and stay at home. She has no water to wash her hands. She has to leave her home to go somewhere else to shower and do laundry. She has to go to the store to buy water. The stores are limiting how much water one can buy.

It's a nightmare, and she is not an isolated case. There are many who also have multiple chemical sensitivities (MCS) and other health compromises who are harmed when the smart meters go in.

Do you know, has Oregon implemented a no-fee opt-out for smart meters, or perhaps another solution? I know Hawaii did an opt-in.

Any other lessons learned from Oregon that may help here would be greatly appreciated, David.
