With the Veteran's Recognition plate, you must show proof of honorable discharge and can get an image of your branch or a medal earned in the open space to the left.



Finally, here's an odd wrinkle. You can get the Paralyzed Veteran plate (below left) even if you are not a vet. The cost is \$20. Or you can get the Disabled Veteran plate (below right) if you prove you are a disabled vet. Cost is \$39.50.
