Program History and Funding

2019

- SB 5538
- 2019-2021 budget provided \$500,000 for stand-up
- ODVA and ODOT form partnership


2019/2020

• RVHT partnership made awards to nine rural transportation providers and one statewide partnership for a total of 10 awards.


2021

- Rural Veteran Healthcare Transportation Grant program (RVHT) was codified in 2021 via HB 2139.
- \$650,000 was appropriated in the 21-23 budget.

End of First Cycle: July 2020 – June 2021



Going Forward

 The request for proposals for RVHT is currently OPEN. Deadline for the first round of applicants is November 29th, 2021

Total amount available: \$650,000

We expect to make 10-15 grant awards between \$35,000 - \$75,000 each
