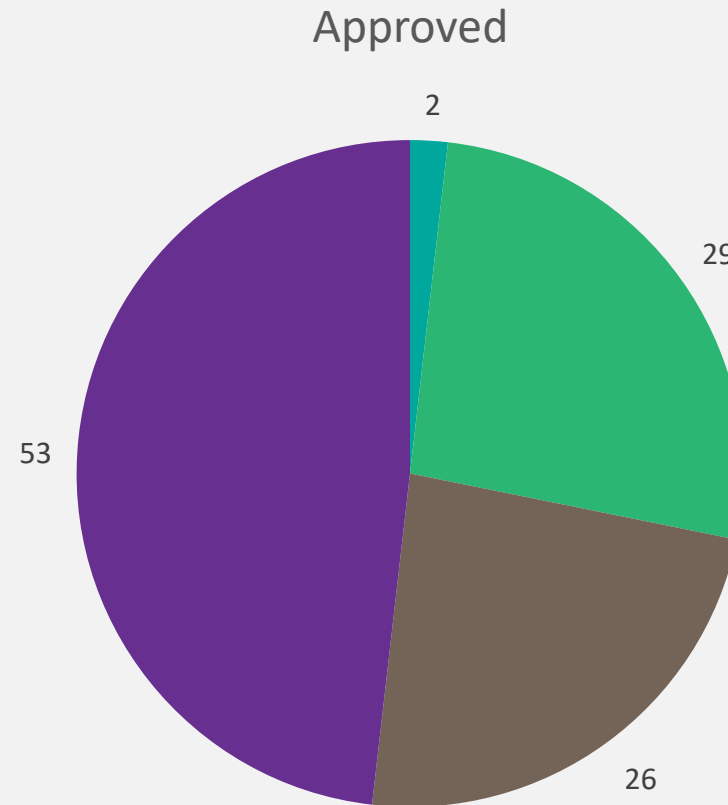

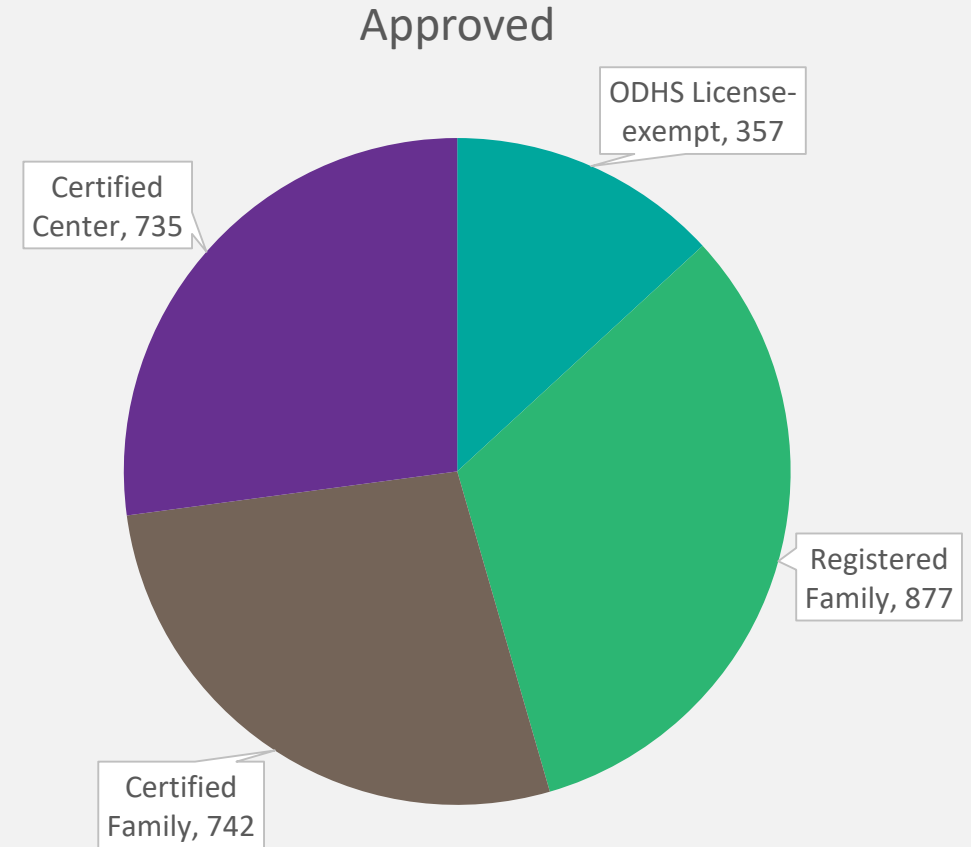

Certified Center (capacity greater than 50)	\$33,326



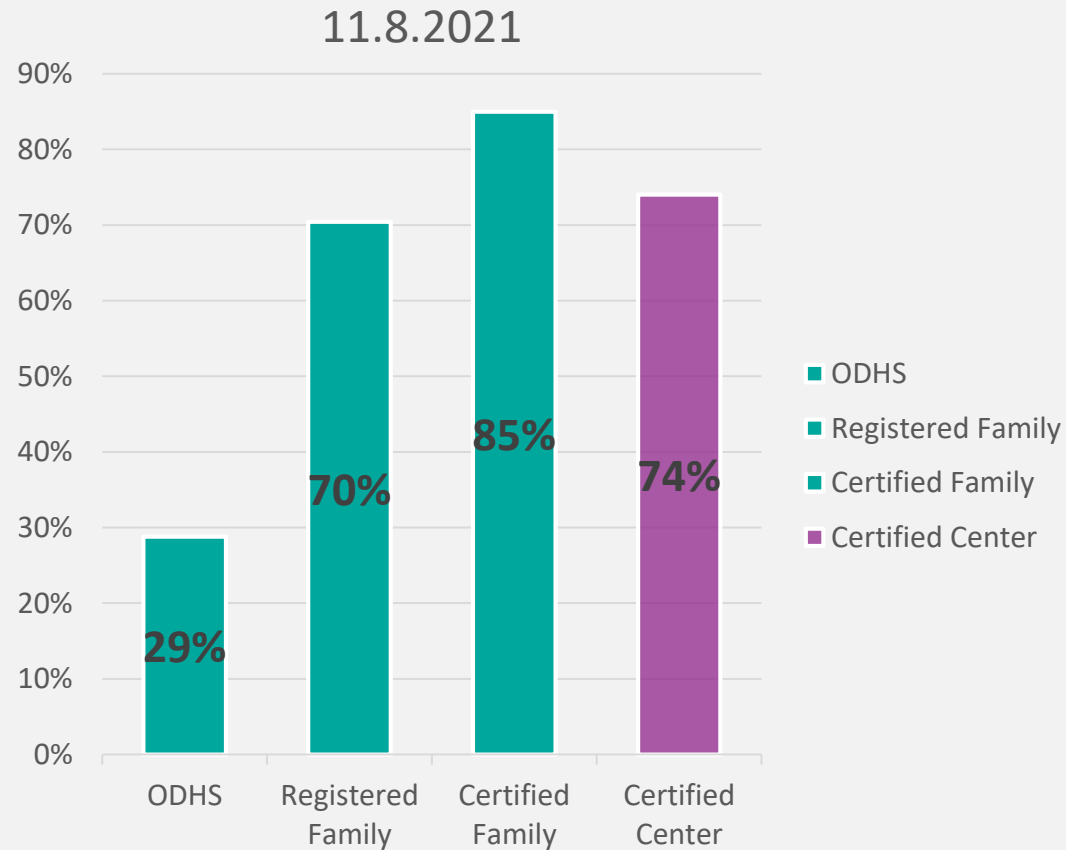

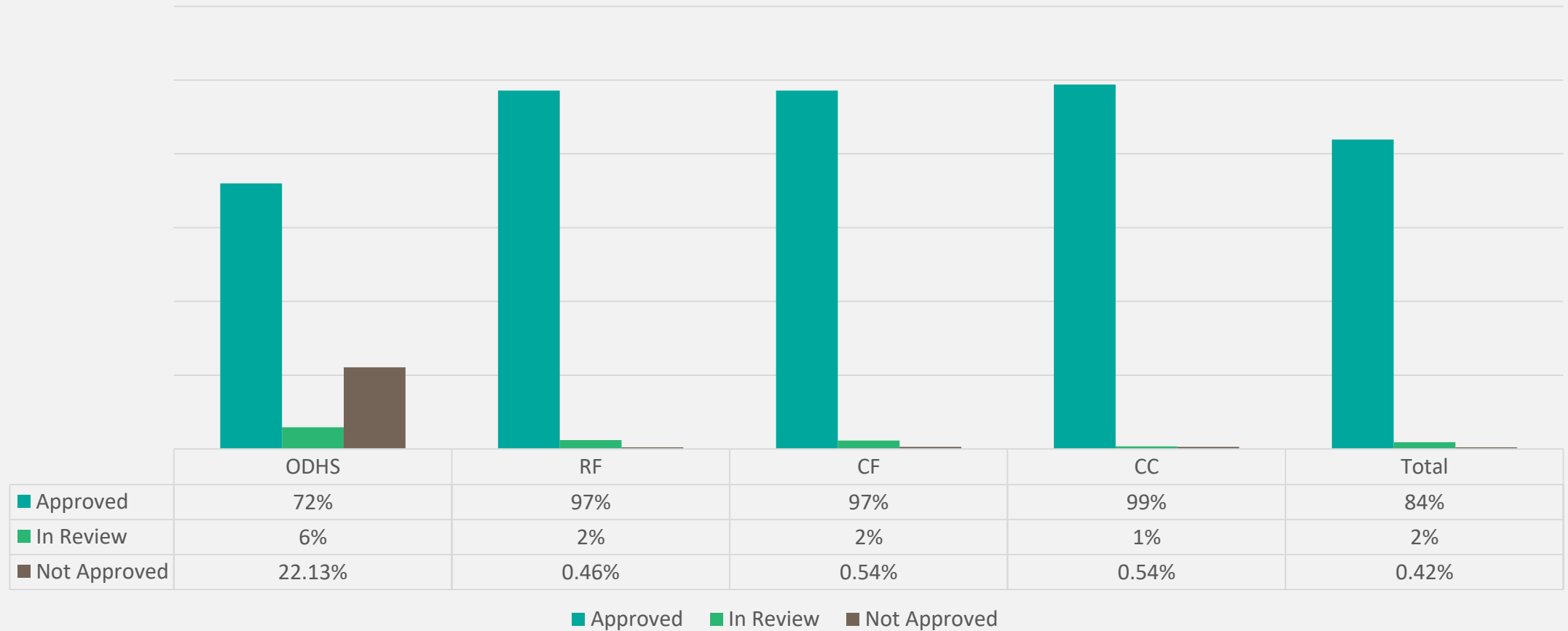




# Saturation Level Submitted Applications
