Citation Information

1333Cases with Class E violations:

- Filed in 30 circuit courts
- 49 with offenses reduced from criminal filed before 2/1/21
- 1284 with Class E Violations alleged on or after the 2/1/21 effective date
- 905 with convictions (70%)
 - 306in court
 - 599 failed to appear
- 73 with dismissals (6%)
- 302 pending (24%)
- 10 were juveniles
- 7 presented with assessment/screening verifications
- 92 people have multiple cases with Class E violations
- Most Class E violations are for possession of meth (67%) or heroin (22%).
- 104 were issued to non-Oregon residents from 15states



County Distribution of Citations

Top 10 counties issuing citations:

- Josephine 243
- Lane 123
- Douglas 104
- Benton 97
- Deschutes 67
- Klamath 68
- Yamhill 64
- Marion 56
- Multnomah 55
- Lincoln 53





Calls and Screenings

Calls to the Line:

- 64 calls from individuals with E Citations
- 45 callers with without citations but looking for resources
- 34 professionals looking for information about BM 110 services

Screenings:

- 46 are not connected to services and declined resources. Just want verification
- 10 are connected to services and declined additional resources
- 8 people are not connected to services but requested resources





Completed Screenings

Top 5 Counties

- Multnomah 11 (7% of citations)
- Douglas 10 (9.5 % of citations)
- Josephine 8 (3% of citations)
- Umatilla 5 (17%)
- Clackamas 5 (100%)

Percentages are approximate as there's an additional month of data for screenings vs. citations





To Increase Effectiveness of Reaching People in Need

- 1) Make sure there are no wrong doors to reaching BHRNs
 - Lines for Life took 8364 drug and alcohol related calls on the Oregon Alcohol and Drug Helpline
- Hotline or BHRN should do follow up with every individuals who receives a citation
- 3) Massive campaign to Rebrand treatment and destigmatize getting help for SUD
