



OUR MISSION

To empower our diverse healthcare workforce to advance in a changing environment through innovative education and training solutions.









THE EDUCATION FUND

- Labor Management Training Partnership serving 105,000 Allied Health workers across 6 SEIU local unions and 19 employers in 6 western states.
- We deliver comprehensive education programs and career services for working adults through preparatory classes, career pathways, tuition support, college courses, wage replacement, continuing education, career advice, registered apprenticeship and more.
- In 2021 YTD have served 23,000 union members in over 80,000 different trainings, services and education programs. Our learners have 50% higher retention, 90% completion in degree and certificate programs, and average 45% wage increases when moving into a new job.



First Cohort of our Sterile Processing Apprenticeship, completed January 2020. Trinidad Garcia de Ochoa's story featured in <u>article</u> <u>for PRISM</u> on low-wage healthcare workers of color to obtaining better paying union jobs.

Registered Apprenticeship

Nationally, SEIU has registered 20 occupations and supported over 3,000 apprentices.

Rapid Response Programming


- Increased online communication with our learners about our many 24/7 online classes for Continuing Education and Critical Skills.

Medical Radiography


This program prepares students for a career as a Radiologic Technologist by completing a degree in Radiology
