STATE AGENCY HB 5006 RECOVERY IMPLEMENTATION SUMMARY

WILDFIRE RECOVERY LEGISLATIVE FUNDING ACTIONS

HB 3127-4 passed out of the House Special Committee on Wildfire Recovery with approximately \$918 million in recovery requests and referred to Ways & Means.

HB 5006 became the primary funding vehicle for 2020 wildfire recovery and included approximately **\$486 million** in recovery funding allocations.

INFRASTRUCTURE Request: \$156 Million - Allocated \$128 Million

REVENUE REPLACEMENT/STAFFING Request: \$152 Million - Allocated \$83 Million

HOUSING Request: \$520 Million - Allocated \$249 Million

NATURAL RESOURCES Request: \$90 Million - Allocated \$26 Million
