Item 19: Oregon Military Department Ten-Year Capital Construction Plan

To: Ways and Means Full Committee

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends that the Joint Interim Committee on Ways and Means acknowledge receipt of a report on the Oregon Military Department's ten-year capital construction plan.

A budget note in HB 5006 directed the Military Department to report to the Legislature on the development of its ten-year capital construction plan. In terms of square footage, the Military Department is the state's second largest facilities manager and maintains a robust capital construction program. The agency's report details the process required by the National Guard Bureau for evaluating facility conditions and requesting federal military construction dollars, the way that armory service life extension projects are prioritized for requesting state bond financing, and the actions taken by the agency to ensure equitable opportunities to bid on its construction contracts.

The Subcommittee recommends approval.
