

Ready to fly?

Make sure to bring the right ID!



- As of May 2023, you will need federally acceptable identification to board a plane, even for domestic flights.
- Your standard Oregon driver license or ID card will not be acceptable for air travel as of May 2023.
- Consider getting the Real ID option when you renew your Oregon license.

Acceptable ID at airport security includes, but is not limited to:

- Oregon driver license or ID card with Real ID option.
 - More info: Oregon.gov/RealID
- Washington enhanced driver license or another state's Real ID license or ID card.
- U.S. passport or passport card.
- Foreign passport.
- · U.S. military ID.
- Federal trusted traveler card.


