OREGON BOARD OF NATUROPATHIC MEDICINE

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Appointees

Meghan Larivee of Hood River; New Appointment Ryan Minarik of Beaverton; New Appointment

Term

Larivee: November 19, 2021 – June 30, 2024 Minarik: November 19, 2021 – June 30, 2024

Appointment/Confirmation Authority

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Statutory Requirements³

The board consists of seven members appointed by the Governor and subject to confirmation by the Senate.⁴ All members of the board must be residents of this state. Of the members of the board:

- Five must be naturopathic physicians who have each practiced continuously in this state for the five years immediately prior to the date of appointment (ERFLING; LARIVEE; MINARIK; SKARPERUD; WALTER).
- Two must be members of the general public who are not naturopathic physicians or a spouse, domestic partner, child, parent, or sibling of a naturopathic physician (ANDERSON; FREEDMAN).

The Governor may select the members of the board who must be naturopathic physicians from a list of three to five nominees for each vacancy, submitted by a professional organization representing naturopathic physicians.

Members serve three-year terms, at the pleasure of the Governor, and are eligible for reappointment but may not serve more than two consecutive full terms. A member must be removed immediately from the board if the member fails to retain qualifications for appointment or has three consecutive unexcused absences.

The board must annually elect one of its members as chair.⁵ The chair has power to summon witnesses, administer oaths, and take testimony and affidavits.

Duties and Authority

The board protects the public by licensing and regulating naturopathic physicians.⁶ The board must:⁷

- administer licensing for naturopathic physicians, including minimum requirements, examinations, reciprocal licensing, continuing education, and specialty certificates;
- adopt and assess fees for specified services;
- when proposing discipline, give opportunity for an administrative hearing; and
- appoint a member to serve on the Council on Naturopathic Physicians Formulary.

The board may:⁸

- offer a program of continuing education in naturopathic medicine and approve a program to be presented by persons reasonably qualified to do so;
- refuse to grant a license, suspend or revoke a license, limit a license, impose probation, issue a letter of reprimand, and impose a civil penalty not to exceed \$5,000 for specified violations;
- for the purpose of requesting a state or nationwide criminal records check, require the fingerprints of specified individuals;
- maintain an action for an injunction against any person practicing, attempting to practice, or claiming to practice naturopathic medicine without a license;
- when conducting investigations: take evidence and depositions; compel the appearance of witnesses; require answers to interrogatories; compel the production of books, papers, accounts, documents, or testimony that pertains to the matter under investigation; and issue subpoenas; and
- impose civil penalties up to \$5,000 for each violation of the laws administered by the board.
