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## ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COMMISSION

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The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Environmental Quality Commission subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

### Appointees

Greg Addington of Klamath Falls; New Appointment  
Amy Schlusser of Portland New Appointment

### Term

Addington: November 19, 2021 – June 30, 2023  
Schlusser: November 19, 2021 – June 30, 2025

### Appointment/Confirmation Authority

### Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>

Required.

### Statutory Requirements<sup>3</sup>

The commission consists of five members appointed by the Governor and subject to confirmation by the Senate<sup>4</sup> (**ADDINGTON**, BARASO, GEORGE, KILE, **SCHLUSSER**) Members serve four-year terms and at the pleasure of the Governor. No member may serve more than two consecutive terms.

### Duties and Authority

It is the function of the commission to establish the policies for the operation of the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) in a manner consistent with the air and water quality policies and purposes established in statute.<sup>5</sup>

The commission must:<sup>6</sup>

- adopt such rules and standards as it considers necessary and proper in performing the functions vested in the commission by law including rules for the administration of specified programs, fees, and civil penalties;
- appoint a Director of DEQ who holds office at the pleasure of the commission and provide policy direction to the director and agency;
- administer licenses, permits, certifications, and other authorizations related to sewage treatment and disposal, air quality, and water quality;
- administer federal air and water quality requirements;
- maintain and administer specified funds and grants;
- receive aid and advice from specified advisory committees;
- review and investigate applications and issue orders as necessary to administer air and water quality policies; and
- establish specified priorities for DEQ.

The commission may:<sup>7</sup>

- adopt rules for the administration of specified requirements including specified fees and standards for sewage treatment and disposal, air quality, and water quality;
- grant specified authorization to, approve specific actions by, and delegate specified duties or authorities to DEQ, the director, the Oregon Health Authority, and other specified entities;
- access any pertinent records relating to any property for the purpose of investigating either an actual or suspected source of water or air pollution or air contamination, including but not limited to blueprints, operation and maintenance records and logs, operating rules, and procedures;
- when the commission has good cause to believe that any person is engaged or is about to engage in any acts or practices which constitute a violation of the laws administered by the commission, institute actions or proceedings for legal or equitable remedies to enforce compliance or to restrain further violations;
- conduct public hearings, issue subpoenas for the attendance of witnesses and the production of books, records and documents relating to matters before the commission, administer oaths, and take or cause to be taken depositions and receive such pertinent and relevant proof as may be considered necessary or proper to carry out duties of the commission;
- assess, remit, or mitigate civil penalties for specified violations;
- accept federal funds and assistance, grants, and gifts and participate in federal matching fund programs;
- institute actions or proceedings for legal or equitable remedies to enforce compliance with specified provisions;
- enter into specified agreements with local units of government;
