### Oregon Need for Rent Assistance is Not a Partisan Issue

Good morning, this is Tom Cusack. I live in Lake Oswego, am a retired HUD Oregon Field Office Director and author of the Oregon Housing Blog.

To inform the members of the Committee and the Legislature I recently updated Census data for each legislative district in Oregon extracting the count and percentage of renters who pay either

- 30% of more of their income for rent.
- 50% or more of their income for rent (Severely cost burdened renters).

After reviewing the data in the table below and in the 3 following pages it is clear that

Cost burdens and severe cost burdens are NOT found in districts represented ONLY by Republicans OR ONLY by Democrats

#### With very little deviation, in ALL districts, Republican or Democratic

- 1 out of 2 renters pay 30% or more for rent
- 1 out of 4 renters were severely cost burdened, paying 50% or more for rent

#### Statewide there were

- 287,983 renter **households** paying 30% or more for rent.
- 145,586 renter **households** who were severely cost burdened, paying 50% or more for rent.
