## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to public safety; and prescribing an effective date.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall study the effect of the payment of restitution by defendants on rates of recidivism.
  - (2) The commission shall provide the results of the study, including any recommended legislative changes, in a report to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than December 31, 2022.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2022 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.
- SECTION 3. This 2022 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2022 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
